Purdue School of Engineering and Technology, IUPUI



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- Concerns about 2009-10 State appropriations and capital projects
 - 1% cut from the 2008-09 budget (\$48K for school)
 - 3-5% cut in State appropriations for 2009-11 budgets (\$450K for school)

• Concerns for IU Foundation investments

- Close to 27% loss in 2008
- Still 8% overall gain during the past 10 years
- Diversity plans
 - \$1M is reserved for new and/or successful continuing programs on all IU campuses.
 - 11 awards were given.
 - Our school received \$90K for 3 years.

 - Plan needs to be in synergy with the School research strategy and core areas

- Promoted by the Dean's Diversity Council
 - Objectives:
 - Increase the yield for matriculation to IUPUI of MEAP, POWER and Pathways to Engineering
 - Improve the semester-to-semester GPA & retention rates of both those students transitioning from our summer & Pathways programs as well as those students progressing to more advanced study.
 - Increase number of diverse and underrepresented students in the academic pipeline with accelerated growth through to graduation.
 - Increase the campus and community profile of our three preprofessional student organizations in addition to increasing improving student numbers and participation.
 - Enhance faculty, mentor, mentee links
