IUSD Research Day....April 16, 2012 is Coming!

Just ten days away is Monday, April 16th, (only 11 days left to get your taxes filed or file for an extension), but more importantly come explore the wonderful exciting world of dental research and see what is happening at the dental school to improve diagnosis, treatment and ultimately the quality of patient care. Basic science research is the bedrock of our profession which leads to translational research, and clinical trials. Dr. Martha Somerman, Director of the NIH National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research, will be our guest and one featured speaker in the afternoon along with IUSD Research Day founder, IUSD graduate and former faculty and administrator--our own, Dr. George Stookey who started this research event twenty years ago. The program begins at 12:30pm in the Campus Center 4th floor.

Building and Facilities Update

New Building Program: Another milestone has been achieved for the new building program. The initial blocking and stacking concept of a space plan has been submitted to main campus for their review and approval. As reported last month, Adam Smith has been working with me, the university planners and architects on general space requirements for our new clinical and research building. We submitted a proposal for about 100,000 gross square feet in a new building to be contained in a 4 story structure (20K sq ft/floor) plus a basement. Exact details on what clinics and research activities go where to follow soon.

Conference Room DS421: Check out DS Conference room 421 next time you are near the dental hygiene clinical area on the fourth floor. Renovation is winding down for this totally updated conference room which will serve as the headquarters conference room September 10-12, 2013 as we host the CODA accreditation site visit team for a two and one-half day on-site re-accreditation review of all our dental education programs.

In December, I announced an exciting new IT initiative working with the IU School of Medicine to improve our planning, integration and delivery of comprehensive information technology services as a strategic priority for IUSD going forward. This change was made as result of a spring 2011 external review of the IUSD-IT operations. Effective April 1, 2012, Vince Sheehan has assumed the new role as Chief Information Officer to lead our IT Shared Services model with the IU School of Medicine. This is important as we enhance our IT operations to improve instruction, research and patient care. Welcome Vince!

Representatives from IUSD along with our fellow IU health professions schools will participate in a "train the trainer" 3 day conference conducted by Toronto which is considered by many to be the International leader in IPE. Thanks for Dr. Laura Romito who is part of the planning committee for this initiative. In May 2011, ADEA along with 5 other national health professions released Competencies for IPE.

IUSD has an operating budget for next year (2013) of about \$45.6 million and derives revenue from the following three major sources: 1) state support 29.5%; 2) tuition and fees 45.8%; and 3) clinical services 24.7%
