Proposed SLA Faculty Assembly Resolution on Parking Monetization

The <u>Faculty Assembly</u> of the IU School of Liberal Arts joins the <u>IUPUI Faculty Council</u> in expressing its serious concerns about the University's plan to generate revenues from campus parking. We respectfully submit the following <u>two</u> resolutions.

Whereas a long-term lease of parking facilities to an outside contractor will result in parking funds being diverted from the legitimate needs of the university to private profit:

(1) We ask the Board of Trustees to maintain University control of parking facilities and operations.

<u>Whereas</u> any attempt to generate increased revenue from parking will impact faculty and staff at IUPUI as a *de facto* pay cut and undermine the university's mission to provide an affordable education to its students and to improve on-time graduation rates:

(2) We ask the Board of Trustees to submit any parking monetization plan to a campus-wide referendum.
