The IUAA assists the university in furthering the international scope of IU and works with IU to assist students with opportunities to travel and study abroad.



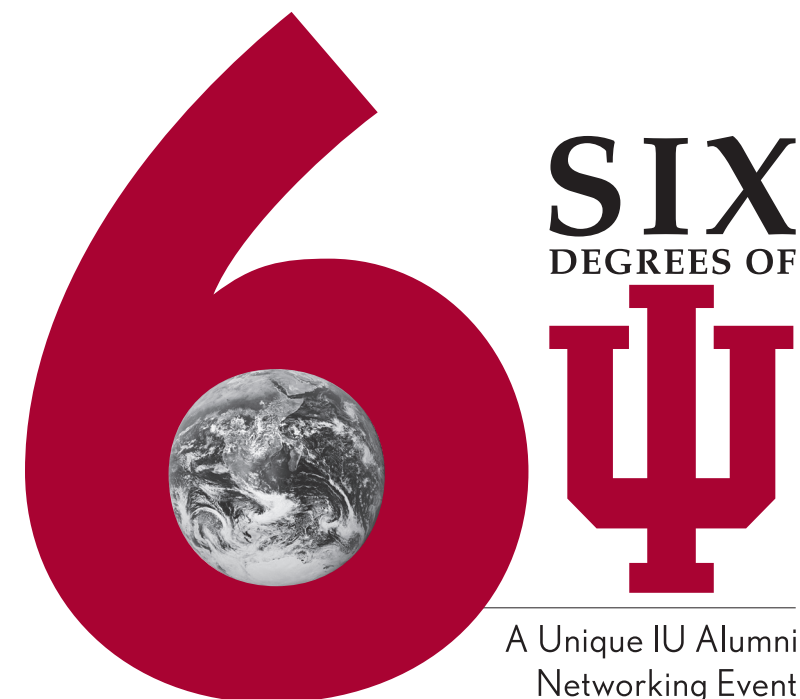

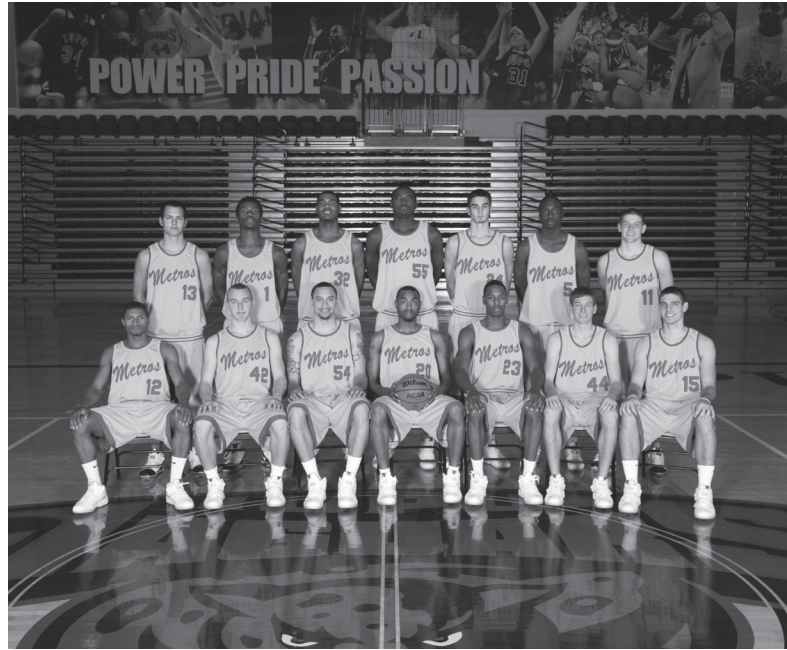

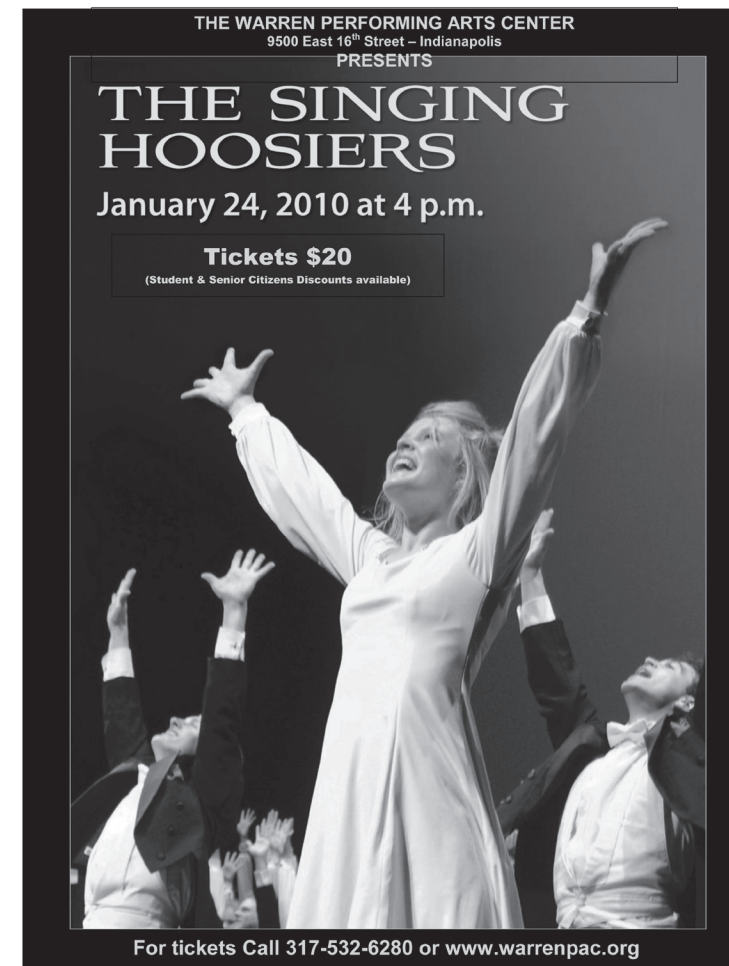
