文化讲座

孔院每周三中午一小时文化讲座一如既往地进行。本学期的文化讲座从中国人如何迎接新年开始,在3个月内,共举办了8场文化讲座,具体内容包括:迎接新年;留学中国;跨国婚姻家庭的教育综合观;广州历史——世界的十字路口;中国针灸的理论与实践;中国音乐介绍;中国国有商业银行的管理、中国建筑。丰富多彩的内容为美国朋友开启多角度了解中国传统文化与当代社会生活的窗口。

春节活动

为迎接 **2017** 年中国新年的来临,印第安纳波利斯孔子学院开展并参与了一系列庆祝活动。

(一) 老人院里迎新春

1月20日星期五下午,印第孔院中方院长张念博士和两位中文老师及办公室主任Noah去到位于印城南部的Magnolia Springs Southpointe疗养院陪同那里的老人们一起迎接



Chinese Language Teaching

1. Chinese Language Courses

Chinese credit courses offered to IUPUI students during the 2017 spring semester commenced on January 9, 2017. These included the C131, C132, C202, C302, C320 and C334 credit courses. A free 8-lecture course in Chinese language for faculty began on February 14.

2. HSK-Chinese proficiency web-based test

CI-Indy hosted its web-based Chinese proficiency test on March 19. The HSK levels that students undertook included Level 3, Level 6 and HSKK (Primary level), HSKK (Intermediate level).

Culture Hour

Culture hour talks were offered to the public each Wednesday at noon throughout the semester, beginning with the Chinese New Year. Eight culture lectures were held over an three month period including Chinese music, architecture, acupuncture, history, and education, etc. These sessions open a window to assist Americans in understanding traditional Chinese culture and contemporary social life.

Spring Festival Celebration

To welcome in the Year of the Rooster, CI-Indy held a series of activities:

1. Celebration with Senior Living Residents



On the afternoon of Friday, January 20, CI-Indy staff visited Magnolia Springs Southpointe to celebrate the Chinese New Year with Senior

Residents. Dr. Zhang Nian introduced the historical development of the Spring Festival and its customs and legends. Chinese teachers wrote Chinese names for the seniors on Zodiac paper card. Noah Buonanno played the piano and sang. The event lasted more than two hours.

2. Culture Talk on Chinese New Year

As the first lecture of the semester, on January 25



Dr. Zhang Nian introduced

the topic of the Chinese New Year, and the legend of the Chinese zodiac Dr. Zaocheng Xu demonstrated the rituals that the Chinese use to worship each other. After the lecture, the guests were delighted to taste various Chinese cuisines.

3. Indy Chinese New Year Activities

The annual Indy Spring Festival Carnival was held on January 29 at the Wildfield High School. CI-Indy hosted a game of riddles in both Chinese and English. In the evening, there were performances. The IUPUI Chinese Student Club performed Chinese martial arts.

4. Indy High School New Year Activities

On the afternoon of February 3, all members of CI-Indy came to Brownsburg High School to celebrate the Spring Festival.



Students performed the lion dance, sang Chinese songs, and played musical instruments. Dr. Zaocheng Xu discussed the annual high school summer camp in China. The Chinese teachers conducted a range of activities including calligraphy and making pandas with white paper and black cardboard.

5. Chinese Festival Exhibit

A Chinese Festival exhibit was held at the art gallery in the IUPUI campus center for the month of February. Every Monday had a theme including Chinese Spring on February 6, Chinese movies on February 13, Chinese Kung Fu on February 20, and Chinese games on February 27.

Meetings

1. 2017 CI-Indy Advisory Board Meeting

On February 27, the 2017 Confucius Institute in Indianapolis Advisory Board meeting was held for the first time at Sun Yat-Sen University. The meeting was moderated by Vice President

Members of the IUPUI delegation included Professor Nasser Paydar, Chancellor of IUPUI, Professor Kathy Johnson, Executive Vice Chancellor of IUPUI, Professor Gil Latz, Associate Vice Chancellor for International Affairs, Professor Thomas Davis, Dean of the School of Liberal Arts of IUPUI, Dr. Zao C Xu, Director of Confucius Institute in Indianapolis, and Dr. Nian Zhang, Associate Director of Confucius Institute in Indianapolis. At the meeting Chancellor Paydar presented a plaque to Professor Zhou Xiaobing of SYSU's School of Foreign Languages in recognition of his

outstanding contribution to the Confucius Institute in Indianapolis. Dr. Zao C Xu made the 2016 work report and the 2017 work plan for the Confucius Institute. In the afternoon



Professor Luo Jun, President of SYSU, met the IUPUI delegation. President Luo welcomed the delegation on behalf of SYSU, and introduced recent developments at his university. He said that IUPUI and SYSU have a long history of cooperation in many fields, and he hoped to further deepen and extend cooperation and exchange between the two universities. On the afternoon of the same day, the 3rd SYSU-IUPUI Cooperative Development Committee Meeting was held. The meeting was moderated by Vice President Yan Guangmei. SYSU Representatives from the Office of International Cooperation & Exchange. Representatives of the Department Education Administration, Center for Teaching Development, School of Nursing, School of Data and Computer Science, School of Earth Science and Geological Engineering, Sun Yat-sen Business School, and Institute for Southern China Philanthropy attended the meeting. The two sides exchanged opinions on joint degree programs, student exchanges, faculty visits and research collaborations.

2. 2017 CI-Indy Program Committee Meeting

On March 17, the CI-Indy 2017 Program Committee meeting was held at IUPUI. Representatives from IUPUI, our Confucius

classrooms, WFYI, the municipal government, the Indianapolis Children's Museum and Eli Lilly & Company were in attendance. The meeting was hosted by Executive Vice Chancellor of IUPUI, Professor Gil Latz. Dr. Zaocheng Xu, Director of CI-Indy, reviewed the CI-Indy work of 2016, and introduced the 2017 work plan of the Confucius Institute.



Other Activities

1. CI-Indy Attends IUPUI Spring Study Abroad Expo

The IUPUI spring semester study abroad expo was hosted by the IUPUI Office of International Affairs at the Campus Center on January 17, 2017. CI-Indy introduced the scholarship application procedures and our study abroad programs in China, including a Summer Camp for college students and a Chinese Bridge Summer Camp for high school students.

2. CI-Indy Attends IUPUI International Festival

The IUPUI International Festival was held on February 22 at Campus Center. Chinese, Spanish, Japanese, French, and Italian were the major languages and cultures showcased.
