

## 重要会议

印第安纳波利斯孔子学院理事会召开 2015 年度会议



5月1日,印第安纳波利斯孔子学院理事会在 IUPUI 召开 2015年度会议。本次会议的中心议题是"孔子学院发展远景(Future Growth of CI-Indy)"。来自中大的理事会代表包括:颜光美副校长、附属一院肖海鹏院长、外事处古文力副处长、汉语推广办公室冯洋女士。IUPUI 代表:校长 Charles Bantz;常务副校长 Nasser H. # 汉语教学

### 非学分课教学

在汉语教学方面,印地孔院承担着 IUPUI 中文项目的大部分学分课程,并单独开设非学分课,教职员工免费汉语班,还提供一对一课外辅导。非学分课主要针对社会人士以及

由于时间冲突等原因不能选修学分课程的大学生而设。上课时间是晚上六点到八点,每周一次。按照汉语水平的高低,非学分课分为"汉语会话1"、"汉语会话2"、"汉语会话3"和"汉语会话4"。每一课程时长6周,每周2小时。



2015 年度 IUPUI 留学中国大学生夏令营圆满结束



5月15日至6月13日,印地孔子学院组织带领13名印第安纳州的大学生远赴中国中山大学开展中国语言文化暑期夏令营。学员们来自IUPUI,IU Bloomington, Butler大学等。跟以往一样,本次夏令营包括三个星期的语言文化学习,最后一个星期是西安北京文化之旅。根据学生们已

有的汉语水平,他们被分到 5 个不同的水平学习汉语,每 天上午接受汉语听、说、读、写训练,下午是中国文化课 程和相关活动,包括音乐、太极、书法、中国文化介绍和 文化体验。语言学习结束后,学员们要通过结业考试,取 得相应的转换学分和结业证书。跟以往夏令营不一样的是, 本次结业考试是 HSK 考试(汉语水平考试)。学员们学习 认真,最后都取得了很好的成绩。结业典礼上,学员们精 心策划组织了一场精彩的结业展示。

# 文化活动

### 第七届中国语言文化节圆满落幕

2015 年 4 月 11 日,由印第安纳波利斯孔子学院和 ICLASS 主办的第七届中国语言文化节在 North Central 高中圆满落幕。此届中国语言文化节由印第安纳波利斯孔子学院、印州中文协会、IUPUI 周末中文学校及其他中小学的校长和中文教师们组成的委员会于 2014 年 11 月开始筹备工作。委员会按照职能分为 9 个部门,分别是:活动委员会、比赛委员会、汉语传承学校委员会、午餐协调委员会、活动现文教师们组成的委员会于 2014 年 11 月开始筹备工作。整个中国语言文化节由四大部分组成:汉语比赛、文化活动、节目表演和颁奖仪式。来自印第安纳州各地的大中小学生齐聚一堂,大家背文章、讲故事、认汉字、赛演讲,在中

### 孔院龙舟舞动印地 500 大游行

2015 年 5 月 23 日,印第安纳波利斯孔子学院再次赞助并参加了一年一度的印地 500 大游行。此游行活动举行于印地 500 英里赛车前一天,它为美国最负盛名的三大赛车盛

事之一摇旗助威。本次游行活动为第 58 届,共有 100 多家单位参加,主题为"纪念我们的五月故事"。印第安纳波利斯孔子学院为此次游行活动精心制作了具有丰富的中国文化元素的龙舟。孔子学院还特地请来了 ICCCI 的专业舞蹈队在龙舟上表演。在游行中,很多观众主动用汉语向龙舟上的表演者和志愿者们打招呼,如"你好!""谢谢!"。



### 印地孔院闪亮第 45 届艺术博览会

2015年5月16日-17日,印第安纳波利斯孔子学院参加了印第安纳波利斯第四十五届 Broad Ripple 艺术博览会。一年一度的 Broad Ripple 艺术博览会始于 1971年,是在印第安纳波利斯艺术中心举行的最大的募捐活动。每年有逾225名来自美国和加拿大的艺术家在博览会上展出作品,平均吸引15,000多名参观者。2014年,印地艺术博览会被"阳光艺术家"列入美加艺术和工艺品博览会前200名的名单。博览会持续两天,展览场地分为艺术区、儿童活动区、美食区和娱乐区等。孔子学院的展台设在艺术区,展出了具有中国特色并吸引众人眼球的文房四宝、红灯笼、中国结、熊猫玩具、毽子、Yoyo、文化图书、折扇等。展会上,孔子学院的老师们踢毽子、玩儿Yoyo,吸引了众多参观者的目光。



### 孔子学院参加印地儿童文化节活动



2015 年 6 月 13 日印第安纳波利斯孔子学院参加了一年一度的印地儿童文化节活动(Kids in the park)。该活动由印地公共广播服务公司(PBS)WFYI 在印地军事公园组织开展。很多学校、社会机构如印地公立学校、印地儿童博物馆、动物园、艺术中心、公立图书馆等都参加了此次活动。孔院的展台吸引了众多亲子团,孩子们在父母的牵引下到展台前对自己感兴趣的物品——观看、欣赏。孔院工作人员的 Yoyo 表演引来了众人围观。

纪念品,包括中文书签、中国古钱项链、印有孔院标识的 笔及纹身图标等。



### 2015 CI Indy Advisory Board Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of the CI-Indy Advisory Board was held at the IUPUI Campus Center on May  $1^{\rm st}$ . The theme



of the meeting was 'CI-Indy's future growth'. Representatives from Sun Yat-sen University (SYSU) joined IUPUI and central Indiana community leaders for the meeting. Special thanks to Vice President Guangmei Yan of SYSU, Dean Haipeng Xiao of the 1<sup>st</sup> Affiliated Hospital of SYSU, Associate Director Wenli Gu of SYSU Foreign Affairs Office, and Ms. Yang Feng who made the long journey to Indianapolis from Guangzhou. IUPUI representatives included Chancellor Charles Bantz, Executive Vice Chancellor Nasser H. Paydar, Associate Vice Chancellor Gil Latz, founding Dean of the School of Philanthropy Gene Tempel, and Dean of the School of Liberal Arts, Thomas J. Davis. Chancellor Bantz was named 'Board Member of the Year.'

### Mandarin Chinese Teaching

#### Non-credit course

CI-Indy Chinese instructors teach the majority of credit courses offered by the IUPUI Chinese Program and they teach non-credit courses as well, including free Mandarin classes for faculty during the day, and evening classes for the public. Evening classes are of 2 hours duration and are held over a six week period.

CI-Indy sent 13 college students to Summer Camp in Sun Yat-sen University from May 15 to June 13. The students came from IUPUI, IU Bloomington, and Butler University. They studied Mandarin Chinese and Chinese culture during the first three weeks, and then in the final week they visited Xi' an and Beijing to explore Chinese historical sites and experience folk culture. After the study period the students undertook HSK tests and all scored well.

### Cultural Events

The 7<sup>th</sup> Chinese Language and Culture Fair
Hosted by CI-Indy and ICLASS, the 7<sup>th</sup> Chinese Language and
Culture Fair was held at the North Central High School on
April 11, 2015. The preparatory committee included members
from ICLASS, ICCCI, school principals, staff from the IUPUI
Sunday School, CI-Indy, and other Chinese language teachers.



The committee was divided into nine functional subgroups that included: activities, competitions, heritage school, lunch coordination, performances, registration, volunteers, and so on. The fair consisted of four parts: a Chinese language competition, cultural events, a talent show, and award ceremony.

### **Indy500 Festival Parade**

The 58<sup>th</sup> Indy500 Festival Parade was held on May 23, 2015 in downtown Indianapolis, one day before the world-famous



Indy500 car race. This is the eighth year that CI-Indy has taken part in the parade. Each year CI-Indy showcases a spectacular emblem characteristic of Chinese traditional culture, and this year it presented a colorful smoke-breathing mobile dragon with dancers performing classical Chinese dance on board.

# CI-Indy at the 45<sup>th</sup> Broad Ripple Art Fair

The annual Broad Ripple Art Fair was held in



Indianapolis on May 16 to 17, 2015. The Indianapolis Art Center and the surrounding meadows were the venue for exhibits. The annual Art Fair hosts 225+ artists and attracts over 15,000 visitors. Painters, musicians, dancers, sculptors, ceramists and other artists shared their own unique talents at the Fair. CI-Indy also had a booth featuring unique cultural products including traditional stationary sets, toys, books, and ornaments.

## Indy Kids in the Park

CI-Indy participated in an annual festival at Military Park called 'Kids in the Park' on June 13. It was hosted by PBS WFYI,



and many schools, local museums, libraries and other institutions participated. CI-Indy showcased unique traditional Chinese culture and attracted much attention.

### **Chopsticks Games hot in Asia Festival**

The 8<sup>th</sup> Asia Festival was held at the Indiana State Museum on June 20, 2015. The festival highlighted Indian culture, and there were many booths showcasing Indian clothing, treasures, tea, and essential oils, etc. CI-Indy demonstrated the 'chopsticks game' at the fair: game participants needed to put as many popcorn or candies as they could into a cup by using chopsticks in one minute. After the game, the



participants could choose one of their favorite souvenirs such as a bookmark, ancient coin necklace, pens or tattoo stickers.
